# **General Information**

## Generic Pricing Procedure

Orthotic or prosthetic catalogue numbers starting with an "N" are generic benefits which have their prices indicated as a "Max. Each." Please use the AADL Generic Calculator to determine the maximum "AADL price" that is funded for generic benefit item catalogue numbers, including any associated "upgrade" amount that is not funded by the AADL Program.

The Specialty Supplier may only bill the client for upgrade costs up to the amount indicated in the calculator. Upgrade costs may be waived or reduced from the calculated amount at the Specialty Supplier's discretion. Refer to the General Policies and Procedures Manual for more information about upgrade costs.

#### Procedure:

- Ensure the client has a valid authorization for the appropriate benefit type on the Alberta Blue Cross Online Health Portal (OHP)
- Locate the catalogue number and enter the manufacturer invoice cost for the component into the calculator. Do not include shipping costs, exchange or any other cost. The cost used for the generic catalogue number must be the manufacturer's invoice cost only. The calculator will automatically add mark-up, shipping and labour costs.
- Costs over the program maximum are indicated in the calculator and are considered an upgrade.
- Record the calculation on the client's record, including manufacturer and model number of each product claimed; record must be provided to AADL or Alberta Blue Cross request.
- Explain any amounts payable by the client before providing the benefit. Use the claim predetermination function in OHP to determine the cost share amount if applicable.
- Submit a claim for the benefits in OHP, excluding upgrade costs from the claimed amount.

## Functional Levels

Lower Lim	b
Level 0	Does not have the ability or potential to ambulate or transfer safely with or without assistance and a prosthesis does not enhance their quality of life or mobility.
Level 1	The ability or potential to use a prosthesis for transfers or ambulation on level surfaces at fixed pace. This prosthesis is typical for the household ambulator.
Level 2	The ability or potential for ambulation with the ability to traverse low-level environmental barriers such as curbs, stairs, or uneven surfaces. This prosthesis is typical for the limited community ambulator.
Level 3	The ability or potential for ambulation with variable pace. This prosthesis is typical of a community ambulator with the ability to traverse most environmental barriers while participating in activities of daily living that require prosthetic use beyond simple locomotion.
Level 4	The ability or potential for prosthetic ambulation that exceeds basic ambulation skills, exhibiting high impact, stress, or energy levels. This prosthesis is typical of the prosthetic demands of the child or active adult functioning in the community.
Upper Lim	b
Level 5	The ability to enhance a patient's body awareness to improve quality of life and or prepare for the patient's future functional ability.
Level 6	The ability to use the prostheses for basic hand skill activities. Generally, these activities are required for lifting, stabilizing or holding objects between two extremities.
Level 7	The ability to demonstrate a high level of function with the prosthesis that enables a client to perform sophisticated, hand skill patterns. Some typical activities would include grasping and releasing, positioning (pre-position) of the terminal device, or changing to alternate terminal devices.
Level 9	The ability to demonstrate a high level of function with a myoelectric prosthesis that enables a client to perform sophisticated, hand skill patterns.

Prescription Required

\*ERS indicates the benefit is available for early replacement, for clients with an active Lower Limb Early Replacement Socket authorization. When claiming a benefit for early replacement, select the early replacement version of the product indicated by "\_E" after the Catalogue Number - e.g. P020\_E: Knee Disarticulation (Early Replacement).

Early replacement sockets may only be authorized for clients with a new lower extremity amputation at level TT, KD or TF, who received a definitive socket for the same limb in the last two years, or who have complex stabilized issues with volume and/or shape. Early replacement sockets are not to be used for the contralateral limb for a bilateral client. All other requests for early replacement must be submitted to Alberta Blue Cross for approval, using the QFR authorization process.

The grant is paid directly to the Specialty Supplier once the microprocessor knee has been provided to the client (on or after the service date). The client will own the microprocessor knee and AADL will not fund replacement, repair or maintenance of any prosthetic or microprocessor knee on the applicable body side for 5 years.

# **Prosthetic Modifications and Repairs**

AADL will not fund any modifications or repairs to a prosthetic device within ninety (90) days of provision of the device. Specialty Suppliers are required to provide all necessary follow-up to ensure the device is able to be used for the purpose intended without additional cost to AADL or the client.

A prescription and validation certificate are **not** required for minor adjustments or repairs after original fitting of an AADL funded prosthetic device.

The following activities may not be claimed as modification / repair benefits:

trialing new components

Major Modification or Repair to Socket

- trimming/modifications to new gel liners
- gait training
- replacement of components that have a specific catalogue number in the approved product list
- basic maintenance of a prosthesis, for example cleaning the device is the client's responsibility.

Specialty Supplier must document the nature of the work completed and clinical justification on the client's file, and provide copies of this documentation on request.

Requests for Prior Approval benefits must be submitted to Alberta Blue Cross using the Prior Approval authorization stream. Include documentation of applicable material costs, labour hours and clinical rationale. Maximum funded amount and upgrade costs will be determined by AADL.
