## **Tdap expansion – July 1, 2024**

Alberta Health will provincially fund Tdap for adults 18 years of age and older in pharmacies effective July 1, 2024.

In addition to pregnant individuals, the expansion of Tdap eligibility at pharmacies will include the following:

- Individuals 18 years of age or older initiating (including unknown/uncertain or no history of a primary series) or completing a primary vaccine series.
- Individuals 18 years of age or older presenting for a reinforcing dose 10 years after their last Tdap immunization.

**Note:** if a client presents for tetanus-containing vaccine after sustaining a wound and the wound has not yet been assessed by a physician, the client should be urgently referred to their primary physician or be advised to call Health Link at 811 for wound assessment and to determine their tetanus immunization history.

Please refer to the following table for updated Product Identification Numbers (PINs) following the Tdap eligibility expansion. Should a claim be submitted to Alberta Blue Cross, pharmacies will not be required to enter the dose given into Immunization Direct Submission Mechanism.
