## Temporary benefit added to the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*

Due to the unavailability of Mylan-Mirtazapine 45 mg Tablet (DIN 02256126) manufactured by Mylan Pharmaceuticals ULC., Apo-Mirtazapine 45 mg Tablet (DIN 02286637) manufactured by Apotex Inc. will be considered as a temporary benefit for the *Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL)*.

As of November 25, 2015, all claims for Apo-Mirtazapine 45 mg Tablet (DIN 02286637) will be adjudicated to the price published in the most recent *Alberta Blue Cross Drug Price List (ABCDPL)* until further notice. If this situation continues to be a long-term matter then this product is subject to the usual review process by the Expert Committee on Drug Evaluation and Therapeutics, and must be approved by the Minister of Health for addition to the *ADBL* in order to remain as a benefit.
