Alberta Blue Cross[®] Pharmaceutical Services Provider Agreement compliance verification review update

At Alberta Blue Cross®, we are committed to safeguarding the value and sustainability of the benefit plans and programs we are entrusted to administer. To ensure claims are paid appropriately by plan sponsors, we employ strategies to protect the integrity of our customers' benefit plans.

Claiming of Pediasure Oral Liquid (PIN 00999993)

A recent Compliance Verification Review determined some pharmacy providers claimed an ineligible benefit using an eligible Product Identification Number (PIN). The pharmacies submitted the claims under PIN 00999993 which is assigned to Pediasure Oral Liquid but dispensed Pediasure Complete (PIN 00098994), which is not listed as an eligible benefit in the Alberta Drug Benefit List (ADBL) or the Alberta Human Services Drug Benefit Supplement (HSDBS).

As indicated in the Pharmacy Providers Resources page found in https://www.ab.bluecross.ca/providers/pharmacy-resources.php, Pediasure Oral Liquid (PIN 00999993) includes Universal Product Code (UPC) 00055325014003, 00055325013907 and 00055325203735. Any UPC other than these three, including the UPC for Pediasure Complete cannot be considered under PIN 00999993.

The ADBL and HSDBS includes the following as eligible benefits:

- Pediasure Oral Liquid (PIN 00999993)
- Pediasure Fibre Oral Liquid (PIN 00990029)
- Pediasure Peptide 1 Cal (PIN 00989998)
- Pediasure Plus with Fibre (PIN 00999434) with Special Authorization.

Pharmacies may refer to <u>Pharmacy Benefact Number 921 - December 2020</u> for detailed information on nutritional products, including the process of using the list, claim submissions and documentation requirements. The enhanced list also contains product descriptions, package size information and UPC listing.

The reviews resulted in recoveries. As part of our processes, we have returned the monies directly back to the plan sponsor in fulfillment of our obligation to ensure the sustainability of their benefit plans.
